The Company has been supporting this initiative for 6 years.

Implementing Agency: Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) (CSR00003475)

Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) along with Vidyasaarathi a technology-enabled initiative by Protean works to bridge the gap in education finance in the country through an online platform. Students can search and apply for various education finance schemes for which they qualified.
